On October 22, 2019, Jacque Lynn Davis, loving wife and mother of three daughters, passed away at age 64.

Jacque Lynn was born on February 15, 1955 in St. Joseph, Missouri to Jack and Raphael (Van Arsdale) Ryan. She earned her Bachelor of Science from the University of Missouri in Columbia in 1976, and she worked as a blood bank specialist for forty years at St. Alexius Hospital (formerly Lutheran Medical Center and SouthPointe Hospital). On May 21, 1977, she married Donald Francis Davis, and they raised three daughters, Leslie, Amy, and Julie.

Jacque Lynn was bold, intelligent, and creative. She loved folk art, classic movies, comic books, and the blues. She drew digital art inspired by her life and her humor. She folded origami and drew her own origami paper. She sewed dolls and little monsters from recycled fabrics. She loved sashiko and free-form embroidery, and her embroidery was included in the book *Hoopla: The Art of Unexpected Embroidery*. She was an extraordinary cook. Jacque Lynn never stopped learning and sharing her knowledge and gifts.

Jacque Lynn was preceded in death by her father Jack Ryan. She is survived by her husband Donald Davis, her three daughters Leslie (Chris) Jackson, Amy Davis, and Julie Davis (Brad Burger), her two grandsons Jeremy and Dominic Jackson, her mother Raphael Ryan, her three brothers Neal Ryan (Judy Cameron), Mike Ryan (Toni Loker), Greg (Yon) Ryan, her sister Cindy (Mike) Hicks, and several aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, nephews, and in-laws.
