Albert Faulstich Jr. "Al," age 84, of St. Louis Missouri, passed away on August 5 2025. Later in life, he was a cookie chairman for his wife and daughter's Girl Scout troop as well. He was very active in his church community, 40+ years at Christ Memorial Lutheran Church. Al also followed in his father's footsteps as a Mason and Shriner, rising to Potentate in 2003. With Al's infectious laughter and playful nature, he made lifelong friends in every group he was involved in.
