Barbara (1934-2022) died peacefully. She is survived by her beloved husband of 64 years, Austin (M.D.); three children, David (Tatiana), Jane (John), and Laura; three grandsons, Austin, Jackie, and William; a brother, John; and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her sister and by her parents, Professor Raymond Jackson and Natalie Jackson.

Barbara grew up in Rolla, where her dad was a professor of mechanical engineering at Missouri School of Mines, and her mom, a former schoolteacher, was a homemaker. Barbara attended Washington University in St. Louis, earning A.B. and master's degrees. She was a teacher of young children, who adored her; two of her favorite positions were at the Miriam School and the Ronald S. Beasley School.

Barbara and Austin raised their family in Brentwood. In later years, they moved to the Bethesda Barclay House in Clayton. They had a wonderful marriage and many friends. Barbara was kind, nurturing, upbeat, and smart.
