“ I first met Bev when she was referred to help with my brother PJ, who had Down Syndrome. She was thrilled to be his companion/helper while I was at work. Although her time with him was very short (he passed away soon after they met) they squeezed what seemed like years of laughter and friendship into just a few months. After his passing, Bev and Herm surprised my husband Ken and I with a memorial brick they had put in Forest Park with PJ's name on it.

Not long after his passing I became the director of a pageant for girls/boys with disabilities, and Bev didn't have to be asked twice whether she wanted to be involved with it or not. She immediately took on the task of collecting items and packing "welcome" bags for all 44 girls and 24 boys. Then she and Herm handed them out at the pageant. I couldn't tell who was having more fun, the participants, or Bev & Herm. Until her passing she was still trying to help with the pageant this year. She even sent a donation from her bed in the ICU. I told her it was not necessary, but she insisted saying, "I don't want the kids to miss out because I'm here."

I have never met a more loving, caring, giving woman in my life. My heart is heavy with the loss of her, but it rejoices in the gain of Heaven, because there's a new angel in town, and her name is Bev. I can only imagine the games she is playing with my brother now and all the things they are talking about since they last saw each other.

May warmth and memories help Herm and the family left behind, to brave the days that lie ahead. Just know, she will always be with you and is continually sending her love.
