



Cathlean [Haas] Roemmich

Cathlean [Haas] Roemmich left this world to be with Jesus on November 16, 2020 at 7:10 pm. She died of natural causes after a recent heart attack [Sept. 21] at the age of 88 . Cathlean was the third oldest of 15 children born to parents, Amy Pearl [Rolland] and Julius George Haas.

Cathlean is survived by her daughter, Linda Stewart, of Shrewsbury, MO and her three sons : Danny Roemmich, Philip Roemmich and Melvin Roemmich which also reside in St. Louis.

Cathlean survived two husbands. Daniel George Roemmich was her first love and father of their six children. Dan died at the age of 64 in 1993. Her second husband, Paul Thomas McGruder, died at the age of 84 in 2004.

Her oldest daughter, Dana Catherine Cook, died at age 52 in 2002 in Bono, Arkansas

Her youngest daughter, Deborah Kay Schmidt, died at age 41 in 1994 in San Diego, CA. Her grandson, Jason Wade Stewart, also died in 2001 at the young age of 24.

Cathlean is survived by her 3 sisters : Hazel Roemmich of Creve Coeur, MO, Dorothy [Eddie] Purdue of Jonesboro, AR

and Judy [Junior] Johnson of Mt. Sterling, MO. She also has 14 grandkids, 24 greatgrandkids, and 3 great,greatgrands.

Cathlean loved the Lord. She took all six of her kids to church as children and was blessed by the profession of salvation of all of them. She prayed diligently for all of her kids and family members. She was a generous and giving woman. She financially helped her brother and sisters, her children and grandchildren whenever there was a need. And even friends from time to time.

Her hobbies included piddling in her backyard garden and flower beds. Roses were her favorite. She also loved to sit outside and watch her birds in the trees and at the feeders. Indoor house plants kept her busy too.

Cathlean also spent many hours reading the bible, magazines and Christian based novels. She loved a happy ending. Her life celebrated a happy ending also. She is now in heaven with our Lord and Savior. 2 Corinthians 5 : 8 states that to be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord. And Psalms 116 : 15 says that precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his saints.
