Charles then decided he wanted to live in Rural Retreat Virginia, and have a small farm with 22 acres to be close to his grand children. Later in his life he left Virginia and went back to Sunnybrook in Florida to stay with his son, Chris because of his health concerns. Charles health was too much for Chris, his son, to take care of with him being in a wheelchair that he decided that it would be better for him to be taken care of with professionals in an assisted living facility at Harbor Place in Florida. Charles wanted the rest of his remaining life to be in Missouri and to be closer to his family, and to live in a Veterans Home. His niece, Julie Wood honored all of his wishes and flew him back with her to Missouri where he resided at St. James Veterans Home and later passed away on 10-31-2020 at 10:05am.

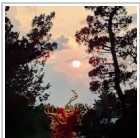

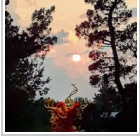
