Harry Charles Drake, 88, of Brentwood, died Sunday (September 17, 2017). Mr. Drake was born September 25, 1928 to Harry Charles Drake Sr. and Louise H. (Hagemeyer) in St. Louis, Missouri.

Mr. Drake served in the Air Force and upon his honorable discharge he continued with the Air National Guard. 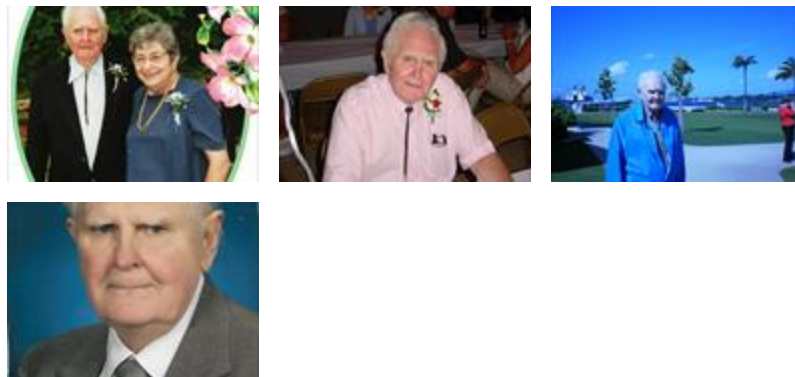
