He had a Master's Degree from Washington University and was a Professor at St Louis Community College for many years. He authored several books and was a world traveler.

He loved giving travelogues, political discussions [always taking the opposite side], and was a master of the understatement. He was a "character" with distinctive dress, a wry sense of humor, and interest in obscure subjects.
