



Dr. John Philip Roemmich DDS

January 3, 1839 - February 17, 1910

Dr. John was born in the Rheinpfalz district of Bavaria, Germany on Jan 3, 1839. The son of John Philip and Elenora [nee Bleistein] Roemmich. He attended school in his hometown, then joined the military for three years. Then studied in Vienna, Frankfort, and Munich graduating with a degree in dentistry.

After practicing dentistry in New York City for one year, he relocated to St Louis where he purchased a dental practice and spent 21 years in South St Louis at 1108 Chouteau Ave.

In 1876, he married Katherine Hertel, daughter of Frederick Hertel [the well known pipe organ builder]. He was a member of the Knights of Honor, an organizer of the Liederkrantz Society, Founder of the Arion Club which started as a Choral Club, and the United Workmen.

He died suddenly on February 17, 1910 when he fell from a Grand Car on his way to choir practice. After 110 years following his death, he will be laid to rest in Valhalla Cemetery with the rest of his family.

“ John Philip Roemmich [Jan.3,1839 - Feb.17,1910] was my great,great grandfather.He was married to Melissa Katherine [Hertel] on June 8,1876. She is buried in New St. Marcus Cemetery by her parents and sister and her son, Alfred. John Philip's cremated remains have finally been laid to rest with my father, Daniel George Roemmich [Mar.21,1929 - Nov.8,1993] and my mother Cathlean [Haas] Roemmich [Nov.30,1931 -Nov.16,2020] in Valhalla Cemetery at 7600 St. Charles Rock Rd. in St. Louis, MO. Dan's identical twin brother, Don [Donald William Mar.21,1929 - July 21,2001] is buried in Memorial Park Cemetery next to his uncle Philip Louis Roemmich. My grandfather was Melvin Douglas Roemmich [Sept.1,1899 - April 7,1961] who is buried in New St. Marcus Cemetery in St. Louis. My great grandfather was Alfred Frederick Roemmich [June 3,1879 - July 19,1956] who is buried in New St. Marcus Cemetery by his mother, Katherine. I am now a Stewart by marriage but I am very proud of my Roemmich and Haas heritage.
