The beloved wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, sister, aunt & friend, Kam-Ying Ko Yeung passed peacefully in her sleep on August 16th, 2021 at the age of 90 surrounded by loved ones who will continue to honor her legacy of selflessness, perseverance, determination and her love of family.

She embodied the Carpe Diem spirit, always up for a fun adventure. The quintessential mother hen, she cared for each child, grandchild and great-grandchild with love and delight (and notable care to everyone's favorite foods!). Her strength, beauty and legacy are an inspiration to all who knew her.
