



Mrs. Vaughnie Lindsay-Skinner

March 31, 1921 - June 4, 2015

Vaughnie Lindsay-Skinner died on June 4, 2015.

She was the mother of Sandra Doreson (Larry) and the late Deborah Rogers (Larry), aunt to Doug Garrette (Cherie) and Linda Garrette, great-aunt to Jennifer Lisy (Adam) and Kimbrell Rakestraw (Ryan), and friend to many.

Vaughnie was born in Prague, Oklahoma in 1921, to the late Irvin and Cora Garrette.

She attended college in Oklahoma and taught at Southwestern State College in Weatherford, Oklahoma. She was married to Joseph Lindsay III and William T. Skinner, who both preceded her in death. She obtained her doctorate at Indiana University (on a Danforth grant) and was an associate professor at Oklahoma University. She was a Professor of Business at Southern Illinois University-Edwardsville, where she was the recipient of the School of Business Teaching Excellence Award. She served as Dean of the Graduate School at SIU-E from 1973-1986.

After her retirement, the school honored her by establishing the annual Vaughnie Lindsay New Investigator Grant in her honor. A memorial service will be held at the theater in The Gatesworth, 1 McKnight Road, St. Louis, MO 63124 on Saturday, June 13, 2015 at 1 p.m. (Valet parking will be provided.)
