



Mr. Wilbur [Will] G. Ericson

October 18, 1924 - February 7, 2016

Wilbur [Will] Ericson passed away peacefully in his sleep at Friendship Village West in Chesterfield, Missouri on Sunday February 7th, 2016 of natural causes. Mr. Ericson arrived into this life on October 18, 1924, the son of Ruth (Truedson) and C. George Ericson, born and raised in Chicago, Illinois with his younger brother Hartley Charles.

Will is survived by his brother Hartley (Jan); and sons: Kyle (Michelle) Ericson, with Tyler (Courtney) and Justin and his son Maksym, Will's great grandson; Gary (Trisha) Ericson, with Jason and Kristy (Kyle); Kevin Ericson with Madeline, Allison, and David; and daughter-in-law Janet Ericson with Connor (Emily).

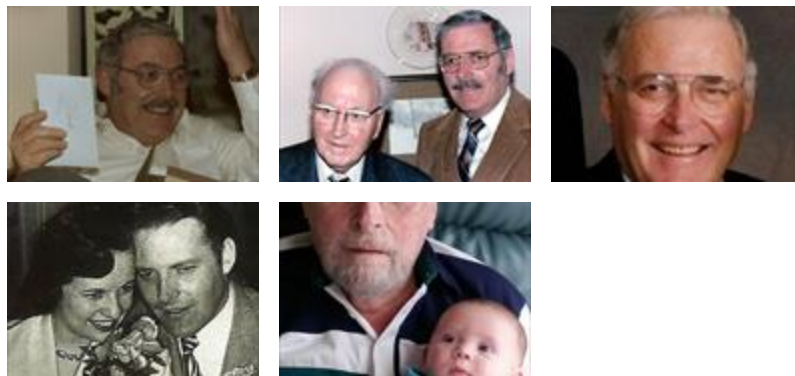
